## 'The issues of rising lorry theft'

Both have had many years of insurance fraud investigation experience and working within the Stolen Vehicle Unit of the Metropolitan Police. The lecture will cover the following topics:

- Truck and load theft and the preventative methods that can be employed.
- Contrived vehicle accidents that are both used as insurance fraud scams and to hi-jack vehicles and their loads.
- Truck watch and similar schemes.



Not only will the evening be an interesting and eye opening experience, it will highlight the current trends of criminals and the methods that are being used.

- In 2009 over **1,600** HGVs were stolen.
- Over **half** the stolen trucks were taken from the operator's premises.
- Last year over **50** vehicles were hi-jacked by criminal gangs.
- There has been a massive increase in the use of violence.
- Average loss per incident now exceeds **£25,000!**
